Description: Science 10 is an online, media-rich course designed to meet the new BC Science 10 Curriculum. The course offers interactive lessons, a variety of guided activities, assignments and labs, and module exams.

Course Modules

- Module 1: Biology - a focus on the big idea that genes are the foundation for the diversity of living things.
- Module 2: Chemistry - a focus on the big idea that chemical processes require energy change as atoms are rearranged.
- Module 3: Physics - a focus on the big idea that energy is conserved, and its transformations can affect living things and the environment.
- Module 4: Earth/Space Science - a focus on the big idea that the formation of the universe can be explained by the big bang theory.
