YVR Art Foundation recently announced our Call for Applications to the 2022 Scholarship Program and we would appreciate your help to spread the word and encourage young artists to apply!

The [Emerging Artist Scholarship Program](#) is for BC and Yukon First Nations visual artists (**age 17-29**) to either attend a school of art or art training program or work with a mentor artist. Awards are for \$5,000 and up to seven will be awarded in 2022. Scholarship recipient artworks will also be on display at the Vancouver International Airport for one year following their scholarship year!
