

Course Title: Graphic Production 11

Description: Graphic Production 11 is a course within the Applied Skills, Design and Technology discipline.

As such, it is an experiential and hands-on program of learning through design and creation of finished products. It fosters the development of the skills and knowledge that will support students in developing practical, creative, and innovative responses to everyday needs and challenges.

The big ideas for this course centre around designing for the life cycle of products, understanding and evaluating one's design choices, and learning how to use specific tools and technologies while adapting these tools for other purposes.

You might notice that this course is called Graphic Production, not Graphic Design. In fact, it is a graphic design course, but it doesn't stop at design. Instead, it focuses on the process of creating useful design products.

This course is primarily assignment-based, with learning guides to help you study the material, and unit quizzes to reinforce learning. Each unit project is intended to help you pull together the skills you have learned throughout the unit.
