

Course: English First Peoples 11
Course Format: Online
Credits: 4
Course Exams: 2 in-person invigilated exams

Description: EFP 11 is a combination of Literary Studies and Writing. This course meets the new Indigenous-Focused Graduation Requirement (effective 2023/24).

This course is the academic equivalent of any English 11 course. Students will develop the English language and literacy skills and capacities they must have in order to meet British Columbia’s graduation requirements. EFP 11 is intended for both Indigenous and non-Indigenous students. This course represents an invitation to all learners to explore and discover First Peoples’ worldviews through the study of literary, informational and media text with local, Canadian, and global First Peoples’ content.

This **4-credit course** is broken down as follows:
