

Course: Spanish 11 Introductory

Course Format: Online, Asynchronous

Description:

Spanish 11 Introductory has been developed to offer an entry opportunity for students who did not begin Spanish in grade 9. It is an intensive course, designed to cover essential learning standards from Spanish 9 and 10 in an accelerated time frame in order to prepare students for Spanish 11. It should be noted that this course does not replace the richness of the regular Spanish 9/10 curriculum.

SAIL follows a Spanish language-learning program called <u>Descubre</u> that is continuous for all grades. The program uses a context-centered approach to language proficiency, where all four language components; Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing, are fully incorporated. <u>Descubre 1</u> builds a foundation of fundamental vocabulary and essential language structures. Themes covered include:

- Greetings and leave-takings, Identifying yourself and others, Expressions of courtesy
- The classroom and school life, Fields of study and school subjects, Days of the week. Class schedules
- The family, Identifying people, Professions and occupations
- Pastimes, Sports, Places in the city
- Travel and vacation, Months of the year, Seasons and weather, Ordinal numbers
- Clothing and shopping, Negotiating a price and buying, Colors, More adjectives
- Daily routine, Personal hygiene, Time expressions
- Food, Food descriptions, Meals
- Parties and celebrations, Personal relationships, Stages of life
